HOW TO DO BUSINESS WITH THE QCTO

Please take note of the following regarding the process to become a supplier or service provider to the QCTO:

- All prospective suppliers are requested to self-register on CSD by accessing National Treasury website at www.CSD.gov.za. All enquiries regarding this registration process may be sent to csd@treasury.gov.za or call 012 406 9222.
- National Treasury will maintain the database for all suppliers for Government and its institutions.
- All QCTO tenders will be published on Government Public Works e-tender publication portal at the following website: www.gpwonline.gov.za; QCTO website on www.qcto.org.za and also at least one national newspaper.

How is QCTO Supply Chain Management governed?

The QCTO's Procurement and Supply Chain Management processes are subject to the provision of:

- the Public Finance Management Act No.1 of 1999(PFMA)
- the Treasury Regulations for departments, trading entities, constitutional institutions and public entities, 2005 issued in terms of the PFMA
- the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No.5 of 2000(PPPFA)
- the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of the PPPFA
- the Supply Chain Management practice notes, instruction notes and circulars issued by National Treasury from time to time
- QCTO's internal delegations of authority

These guidelines and legislations are incorporated into the QCTO's Supply Chain Management Policy. The policy sets out the processes and procedures followed by the QCTO when goods and/or services are procured. It defines the legal and ethical parameters by which QCTO's employees and in particular its supply chain practitioners must conduct supply chain activities within QCTO. This policy enables the proper and consistent application of procurement and supply chain management practices across the QCTO. The policy promotes efficient, transparent, equitable and effective procurement processes so as to achieve optimal value for the money in terms of the total cost of ownership of the goods and/or services procured by the QCTO.
